## A Resolution Adopting Ordinance No. 10-2017, an Ordinance to amend section 36 of Chapter 1064 of the City Code to provide an exception to separately billing owners of multiple residential structures where the owner has entered into a contractual agreement directly with the City refuse contractor.

A local resident who owns two, four-unit apartment buildings located in the City has entered into a contract with Waste Management (WM), the City contractor for refuse pickup, to pay WM directly for providing refuse pickup at these two apartment buildings. Our current ordinance requires that the City bill residential units with four or less units separately, which would result in the owner having to pay twice for service. ## A Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute Grant Agreement P0130595 from the W. K. Kellogg Foundation in the amount of \$1,479,450.

The City of Battle Creek desires to expand its capacity to provide economic and community development services city-wide. In order to support the effort, the city is seeking funds from the W.K. Kellogg Foundation to support the planning and execution of its economic development strategy including funds for staffing, consulting services, materials and supplies and support for project implementation.

This Resolution authorizes the City Manager to execute Grant Agreement P0130595 from the W. K. Kellogg Foundation in the amount of \$1,479,450 over a three year period. **Approval is recommended.**
